Sub: Uploading of data of students on Academic Bank of Credit(ABC) Platform - National Educational Policy (NEP)-2020 – regarding.

Sir/Madam,

Reference AICTE's letter of even number dated 16th October 2023, 6th May 2022 and 14th June 2022 (copy enclosed) on the subject cited above.

As communicated earlier "Autonomous Colleges/Stand-alone institutions" which is an initiative of the Ministry of Education, Government of India, aiming to provide academic flexibility, multi-disciplinary, and holistic education by removing the rigid circular boundaries and creating new possibilities for lifelong learning, ABC's distributed & flexible teaching and learning enable students to learn at their own pace and offering facilities like Multiple Entry and Exit points.

Academic Bank of Credit(ABC) Platform is established to digitally store the Academic Credits earned from various recognized Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) so that the degrees from an HEI can be awarded considering the credits earned. To ensure the realization of the Vision of NEP-2020, the roll of academic institutions is critical by ensuring timely uploading of credits to the APAAR credit repository and depositing them in the students 'APAAR' accounts. This is essential to facilitate the redemption and transfer of credits.

In this context, the Council is in receipt of letter dated 29th July 2024 from Secretary, Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Government of India, New Delhi to ensure all the institutions coming under the purview of AICTE to complete uploading of credit data for academic year 2021, 2022 and 2023 on or before 31st December 2024 in the ABC Platform. It may further be noted that after the time-line is over, the said data will be freezed and no further credit deposits will be allowed in the ABC eco system.



All the institutions are once again requested to follow the direction received from Ministry of Education, Government of India and upload the data as early as possible and adhere to the communicated time-line.

Dear Sir,

Please refer to this office letter of even No. dated 06th May, 2022 (copy enclosed) on the above subject. As communicated vide aforesaid letter 'Academic Bank of Credits (ABC)', is an initiative of the Ministry of Education aiming to provide academic flexibility, multi-disciplinary, and holistic education by removing the rigid curricular boundaries and creating new possibilities of life-long learning. ABC's distributed & flexible teaching-learning enables students to learn at their own pace, stop in the middle of a course, and take it up again whenever it is convenient for them.

- 2. The Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) is an educational digital platform built by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY)'s National e-Governance Division (NeGD) in line with the National Academic Depository (NAD) to facilitate students' seamless mobility between or within degree-granting Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) through a formal system of credit recognition, credit accumulation, credit transfers, and credit redemption. Students can register for a unique ABC ID, access an interactive dashboard to track their credit accumulation and initiate a choice-based credit transfer process via the ABC platform. For academic institutions, the ABC systems provide a dashboard to accept, reject or begin credit transfer requests for students based on course curriculum, as well as search student data, and direct/give feedback/reasons for approval or rejection reasons for credit transfer requests.
- 3. It is requested to register with the Academic Bank of Credits at www.abc.gov.in. A detailed User Manual with step-by-step instructions and screenshots is provided in the ABC portal's Resources area under the General Resources category for both academic institutions and students.
- 4. It is also advised to start accepting documents from DigiLocker for future admission processes which are treated at par with the original documents as per IT Act 2000. Copy of the letter from the Secretary, UGC is enclosed for ready reference. An awareness campaign may also be launched to educate students about Academic Bank of Credits facility and encourage them for opening academic bank credits accounts.
- 5. The team from NeGD will assist you with the on boarding and deployment of your services. For more information, you may contact Mr. Durgarasad Dash, Additional Director (durga@digitalindia.gov.in ph:011-30481649) or Mr. Prasoon Kumar, Sr. Manager, (prasoon.k@digitalindia.gov.in) of the NeGD.
- 6. Ministry of Education is laying serious emphasis on adoption of Academic Bank of Credits by the HEIs and reviewing it periodically. In view of forgoing, you are requested to adopt ABC as soon as possible but in any case not later than 15th July, 2022.
