MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

Janta Multiple Campus, Itahari, Nepal

AND

Shri Jagdisprasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala University, Rajasthan, India

This **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** is entered into on 8th July, 2025 by and between:

Janta Multiple Campus (hereinafter referred to as "JMC"), located at Itahari, Sunsari, Nepal, an academic institution affiliated with Tribhuvan University, committed to excellence in education and community development,

AND

Shri Jagdisprasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala University (hereinafter referred to as "SJJTU"), located at Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan, India, a university established under U/S 2(f) of UGC Act 1956.

Collectively referred to as "the Parties."

Objective

This MoU is aimed at defining a system of shared cooperation and collaboration between JMC and SJJTU amidst the promotion of academic excellence, intercultural understanding, and regional engagement.

Sectors of Cooperation

The Parties will cooperate in the following areas

- Academic Collaboration: Encouraging joint research projects, educational programs, and faculty exchanges to enhance the quality of education and research at both institutions.
- Student Mobility: Promoting student mobility through exchange programs that allow students to study abroad and gain international experience.
- Professional Development: Providing opportunities for professional development via workshops, seminars, and conferences for faculty and staff.
- Student collaboration: Encouraging harmonious collaboration between the student organizations of both institutions.
- Cultural exchange: Facilitating cultural exchange programs for students and faculty to immerse themselves in each other's cultures and traditions, promoting crosscultural understanding.
- Community Engagement: Engaging in joint community service initiatives and outreach programs to address shared societal challenges and contribute to social development.
- Sports Exchange: Promote inter-institutional sports exchanges, tournaments, and training programs to foster physical well-being, teamwork, and leadership among students through joint competitions, coaching initiatives, shared best practices, and inclusive participation for holistic student development.

Execution and Co-ordination

Each Party shall designate a Coordinating Officer to regulate and coordinate the activities. Specific activities will be defined under individual agreements or annexures, addressing timelines, duties, and financial arrangements.

Financial Terms

This MoU does not require parties to incur financial commitments. Financial terms for joint activities will be outlined in separate project documents.

Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)

Unless stated otherwise, intellectual property resulting from shared efforts will be co-owned by both Parties.

Time and Closure

This MoU shall be effective for five (5) years from the date of signing. It may be extended with mutual agreement. Either Party may terminate this MoU by providing a 90-day written notice.

Legal Status

This is a non-binding MoU based on cooperation and goodwill. It does not create any legal obligations and is governed by the regulations of the individual institutions and the laws of their respective countries.

Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising from the interpretation or execution of this MoU will be resolved through amicable discussions and mutual consultation between the Parties. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned have signed this MoU in two original copies on the
