Applicant's Query	Reply
1. That whether Jagdish Prasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala University, Jhunjhunu- Churu- Bishau Road Chudella, Dist. Jhunjhunu Rajasthan-333001, is U.G.C recognized or not.	<u>102:-</u> Jagdish Prasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala University, Rajasthan has been established as a Private University by an Act of State Legislature of Rajasthan as a State University and empowered to award degrees as specified under Section 22 of the UGC Act through its main campus i.e. Rajasthan, with the approval of Statutory Councils, wherever required.
2. That whether the degrees offered by Jagdish Prasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala University Jhunjhunu are valid in India and Abroad.	Jagdish Prasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala University is not authorized to open study centre/ off campus centre beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the state as per the decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of Prof. Yashpal Vs. government of Chhattisgarh. The University can not open its centre even within the state as per the provision of UGC Regulation 2003 without the approval UGC.
	The University cannot run distance education program without the approval of Joint Committee of UGC-AICTE-DEC.
3. That the students can pursue their higher studies in India/ abroad with the degrees granted by Jagdish Prasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala University Jhunjhunu. Rajasthan.	<u>203</u> If the above procedure is followed.
