ABOUT

It is universally recognized for its impeccable credentials of being a top-ranking university among private universities all over the state. It has been an eventful history of 9 years.

The university owes its emergence to the divine inspiration of the almighty who counseled Shri Rajasthani Sewa Sangh, Mumbai to found a university in the name of Shri Jagdishprasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala Ji. The university is seeking strategic alliance and academic collaboration with top most institutions in the field of research and other disciplines. The university is established by an act 2009 vide f2(5)vidhi/2/2009 of the state legislature of Rajasthan and recognized by UGC under section 22 of the UGC act. It is well-equipped with an extensive infrastructure, containing state-of-the art facilities.

The campus boasts of a spacious and well-maintained sports complex for outdoor and indoor games. The self-contained thirty- acre sprawling campus is strategically located on the

Jhunjhunu-Churu state highway road in its green natural environs. The university campus is located 198 km from Jaipur city & 263 km from New Delhi. There are well- equipped laboratories for civil engineering, mechanical engineering, architecture, pharmacy, science, and nursing. In addition, there is an advanced computer science laboratory comprising modern technological setup, equipped with high-speed internet connectivity. The university has highly qualified and experienced faculty, educated from premier institutions of India. The university is research-oriented and having a focus on innovations and novel research. The university has the memberships of various trade associations like ISO, FICCI, COSIA, AIU and CSI India, etc.

To promote education the university provides 100% & 25% tuition fee concession for girls & boys respectively who secured more than 80% marks in their qualifying examination for U.G. & P.G. courses. CENTRAL LIBRARY



In 2009, the Central library came into existence along with the establishment of the Shri JJT University. It acts as a knowledge repository, supporting the academic, research and extension programs of the university. The centrally airconditioned, Hi-Tech, 250-seater library is the focal point of all user community of the university. The library has a comprehensive collection of meticulously chosen 40000 volumes of books (textbooks & reference books), 131 periodicals, national and international journals, magazines, conference proceedings, question papers, project reports, thesis & dissertations and non-printed materials like ebooks, e-journals, CD ROM, DVDs, audio & video-tapes, slides etc in the field of science & technology, engineering, commerce & management, pharmacy, humanities, architecture, education, law, moral & spiritual studies, general topics etc. The library has also a collection of more than 16 newspapers in Hindi/English languages. The Central library is the member of DELNET Online (Developing Library Network), through which it is connected to 6678 national libraries and 22 foreign libraries. DELNET also provides online access to fulltext e-journals in the field of engineering, management, pharmacy, and education. The fully digitalized library utilizes barcode circulation system for smooth and effective functioning and management. Students and staff can borrow books against the library membership card, issued by the library. The library also provides photocopy facilities to students at reasonable charges. All the activities of the Central library are managed by the professional and support staff, providing facilities and a comfortable environment to users seeking knowledge and information. The Central library remains open for 12 hours for all working days except national holidays and major festivals.

Smart Classroom



The classrooms architecturally designed with optimal room for natural light and air. They provide a vibrant backdrop to the academic achievements and offer a unique place to study, relax and develop. The classrooms are equipped with an array of hi-tech equipments which enables the competent teachers to conduct classes in such a manner that the students can make use of all the available resources at the click of a button. 

Accommodation

The students' hostels at campus have been beautifully constructed with large capacity. These offer single, double and triple-sharing rooms at varying rates, as per choice and availability. Located right next to the University sports facilities, the hostels are a picture of action and festivity on most days. There are fully sequestered, secluded residential areas for boys and girls. The hostels have their own housekeeping staff, with an uninterrupted supply of regular water, purified drinking water and electricity. They have round-the-

clock security, with a team of wardens (both male and female) and the proctor staying within the hostel premises. Common rooms are equipped with fully Wi-Fi enabled facilities and television. All amenities including basic grocery shops, canteens/cafeteria, saloon shop, beauty parlor, laundry, ATM's etc are situated very close to Hostels complex in the campus.

Mess Facility



The hostels have a spacious mess with high-quality food served over four meals every day with special lunch and dinner timings for students. The mess menu is highly varied, and is altered periodically in consultation with the students.

In addition to the mess and hostel canteen JJT University has a central cafeteria, with ample indoors seating space. Most of the day, the cafeteria is chock-a-block with patrons looking to grab a delicious snack, a refreshing cup of coffee or a cold drink to beat the heat. In the late evenings, the cafeteria transforms into a restaurant, acting as an alternate eating place for those desiring a change from the regular mess/home food. A variety of sumptuous multi-cuisine dinner items are served, all prepared in the "Vegetarian

Snacks". You will find several groups of students and staff engaged in deep conversation, enjoying a tasty, affordable meal under the clear night sky.

Transport

Catering to a large number of day-scholars, University runs a fleet of buses for the convenience of its students and faculty. Students are charged a subsidized transportation fee for this facility. The buses cover several routes in Jhunjhunu. For campus residents, the University runs weekly buses to the nearby cities. People availing of this facility enjoy a day out on town, with a comfortable ride back to campus in the evening. University places a high premium on the safety, hygiene and punctuality of its transport system. The University takes great pains to ensure these key factors, and has appointed a dedicated Transportation Department to monitor the performance of the service. In addition, University has a fleet of cars and vans for backup transport. When some students are required to stay back late for trainings, extracurricular activities or organizational workshops, activities. University ensures that their transportation is taken care of by this fleet.

Discipline & Security

JJTUniversity has no-tolerance policy towards ragging of any form on campus. Security officials as well as University Officials are on constant vigilance to avoid ragging. JJTUniversity actively counsels all its students against the evils of ragging, and keeping with its core tenet of preventing over curing. Security guards maintain security in the campus. Around 25 Security personnel's are deployed at all strategic points. All students are expected to behave courteously with colleagues, faculty and campus visitors. Any breach of this discipline invites a variety of penalties, including expulsion in extreme cases. Acts of violence, verbal or physical, are not permissible, and are dealt with strictly. A full-fledged internal security and team of wardens work in tandem to ensure a safe and wholesome life on campus. Anti-ragging committees and anti-ragging squads are formed in each college/institute/ school and at university level which keep round the clock vigil against ragging and take appropriate action.

Music Club

This club is a joint initiative of students and faculty. With the University having Visual and Performing Arts & Research, faculty being renowned exponents of several instruments and forms of music, this club is rich with their guidance, ability and involvement. In fact, several students from various streams opt to earn an extra diploma pursuing their musical passion. The club has organized several concerts starring renowned musicians. They are omnipresent mood-setters during religious functions of all kinds. With their immense talent and skill, they play an invaluable role in enlivening the campus environment. New entrants with a musical bent are actively sought out and assimilated into this vibrant club.

National Tours

National tours form an integral part of most of the courses offered here. These help to familiarize students with the latest in their respective domain and develop a better understanding of the world.

Projects

Projects are a crucial part of any programme. The Projects are done by a group of students and are intended to be intensive, active learning projects, requiring significant effort in planning and implementation as well as preparation of a substantial final written work product. The group students are made to choose a project from their domain and asked to conduct practical and real life studies on them.

Internship

In this the students are deputed to work in an organization related to their professional field and thus get trained in that organization. They usually work on a project for the entire duration.

Mock Interviews

Mock interviews are conducted to make the students aware about the level of interviews conducted by the industry expert panel. In Mock Interviews the

University creates a virtual corporate environment for the students and virtual interview sessions are held where the students respond at their final interview day.

Field Trips

Field Trips include students going on a field visit to an organization relating to the profession for which they are being groomed in order to get a feel of the real world's professional demands. They provide a valuable opportunity to discover the realities and practices of the profession the students are aiming for.

Bulletin Boards

There are bulletin boards in every classroom where the students paste clippings from newspapers, periodicals, journals or their own creative work which can be of interest or value to others and give a few minutes presentation on the same. This is followed by a feedback from the rest of the class and a discussion on the point talked about.
